

Kåbe Mat Original

Conditions

Our mats scrape sand and dirt effectively off the soles of shoes. The mats are designed in a way that allows sand and dirt to collect in the mats without them looking unclean. How often you need to clean the mat depends on the amount of dirt that it collects. The mats need cleaning more often when there is a high load, to stop the dirt from forcing the mat out of the frame and causing unnatural wear.

Cleaning

The mat does not need lifting in order to clean it. Using our mat lifter, simply grip the steel wire, close to the aluminium section on the edge of the mat, and fold up by no more than 15 cm or so. It is then easy to roll up the mat, so the dirt and grit can be removed with a brush or a vacuum cleaner.

Only water is used for cleaning, no chemicals! Long mats are rolled to the middle, from both ends. The mats should be turned over at least once a year, so the rubber wears evenly on both sides. This will considerably extend the service life. Occasionally, a strip may move slightly out of place when the mat is rolled up. If this happens, it is important to push it back into place immediately, to prevent damage to the strip.
